The School of Kinesiology invites applications for a **limited-term** faculty position for up to two years. This position is at the rank of Lecturer or Assistant Professor, in Management and Leadership in Kinesiology. The successful candidate will be appointed to the School of Kinesiology (<http://www.uwo.ca/fhs/kin/>) and will be responsible for contributing to a dynamic sport management program at the undergraduate and graduate level.

Duties would include teaching management and leadership courses in physical activity related to the undergraduate and graduate programs in Kinesiology. Ability to teach courses in the following areas is expected: foundations of sport management; globalization/internationalization of sport and physical activity; and sport for development. Knowledge and ability to also teach in a related area such as sport marketing, sociology of sport/physical activity, social-psychological determinants of physical activity or Olympic/Paralympic studies would be an asset.

The successful candidate will be expected to participate in relevant service to the School of Kinesiology and university. Opportunities for collaborative research are also available; the larger percentage of time will be dedicated to teaching (70% to 80%). Candidates must hold a PhD or be near completion in a related field, have demonstrated excellence in teaching and/or research. The candidate will ideally have demonstrated expertise in developing and teaching courses in traditional and flexible learning environments. The effective date of the appointment is **November 1, 2017, or as negotiated to June 30, 2019**. Salary and rank commensurate with qualifications and experience.
