in the Faculty. I would also like to acknowledge the work of Linda Brown and Jess Bechard for their work in compiling this information.

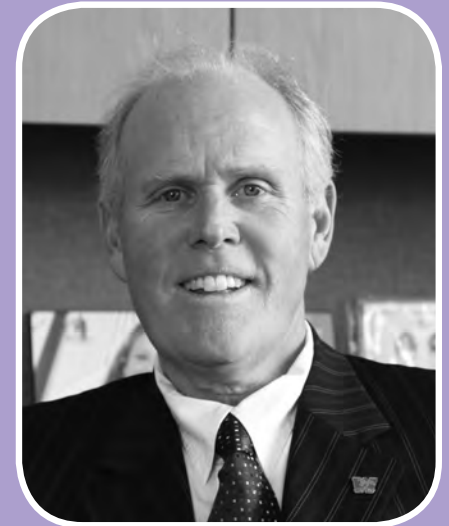

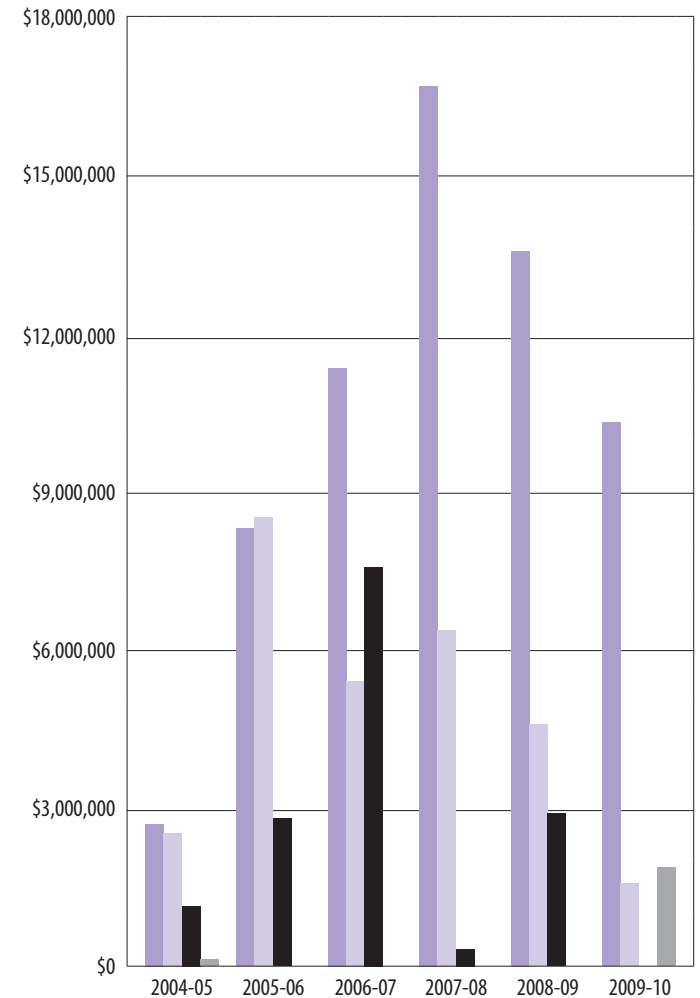
