

From Authentic Totality to Authentic Community: Heidegger's quest for the *Sinn von Sein*

Course Description: This seminar will undertake an intense and comprehensive reading of Heidegger's thought beginning with *Being and Time* followed by a critical study of both Heidegger's *Introduction to Metaphysics* as a transitional text to his later essays on language, art, and technology. The goal of the seminar is to trace Heidegger's thinking of being from the project of fundamental ontology to poetically dwelling in the fourfold.
