ASSEMBLY:

The Faculty Academic Procession will marshal in the North Corridor of Alumni Hall at <u>9:30 a.m. for a morning ceremony</u> and at <u>2:30 p.m. for an afternoon ceremony</u>. All members of the procession will be seated either on stage or in the Right Orchestra section of Alumni Hall. Convocation Board Policy Regarding Hooding of Graduating Students

Faculty members at The University of Western Ontario and other recognized universities will be permitted to hood immediate family members and PhD supervisors will be permitted to hood their doctoral candidates provided that arrangements are made with the Marshal of Convocation (see contact information above) at least one week before the relevant convocation ceremony.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

Those participating in the Academic Procession will be provided with academic regalia [Western colors], free of charge, from a location in the North Corridor of Alumni Hall, just prior to marshalling for the procession. To facilitate this process, participants in the Academic Procession can make email requests for regalia using forms which can be downloaded from the following website address: http://www.uwo.ca/univsec/senate/convocation/index.html or by calling the Assistant Convocation Coordinator at x84540 (msoswald@uwo.ca) and providing the following information: highest degree, height (wearing shoes), hat size [mortarboard is optional].

Regalia **must be returned immediately** following convocation to the same location in the North Corridor of Alumni Hall (**not** the temporary bookstore location for students). This regalia is not provided for use at Faculty awards ceremonies.

GUEST SEATING:

Each member of the Academic Procession will be given **ONE** reserved seat guest ticket upon request to the Convocation Assistant (519- 661-2111, extension 84540).

RECEPTION:

Immediately following the ceremony, the Alumni Association will host a reception for new alumni and their guests in the Great Hall in Somerville House. All those in attendance at Convocation are cordially invited to attend this function.
