AUDIO FEST: SOUND PROJECT AND PARTY

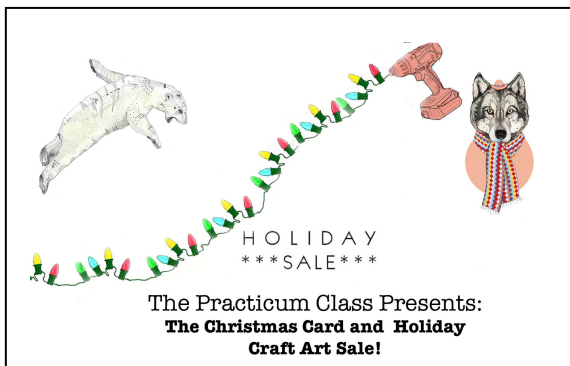
Tuesday, December 7, 13:00-16:00 and continuing... in the halls of John Labatt Visual Arts Centre.
