Minutes

4:05 – Meeting called to order

- Discussion of departmental external review report
 - T. Thorne: somewhat pro-grad students, esp. re: stipends could be raised to meet national standards
 - How to pursue? May wait to see response from administration and bring up through department head if action is not taken
 - Conversation on perceived faculty difficulties with thesis quality & potential alternative avenues for students
 - o Idea of a yearly meeting between faculty and graduate students, similar to the luncheon for the external review
- Automatic deduction campaign discussion
 - T. Thorne presents international student perspective
 - Comment by A.L. Houde re: usual case in other universities, giving students either option
 - Mention that Facebook group has been created for campaign, so will not be conducted through science department mailing lists; interested students may wish to join
 - Last that was heard, leaders of movement had secured a meeting with university administration to present arguments and discuss options
- A.L. Houde describes the new Masters in Management of Applied Science program
 - Q: will this detract from resources available for biology students? Esp. considering faculty have voiced concerns about their workloads. A: theoretically not, should be a separate program altogether
 - First time hearing about this for many representatives
 - General agreement that the program may not be well realized in its first year, opinions voiced re: requests from employers for this type of education
- A.L. Houde presents budget and BGRF final costs update

- Poster boards remain loss leader: executives encouraged to talk to any acquaintances/friends/relatives in carpentry or engineering to estimate cost of building our own
 - Potential to ask department for one-time expense to decrease future costs and therefore their contribution to BGRF
- Some discussion of catering costs and whether food provided could be reduced to save money in future years (often leftovers)
 - A: provided by Great Hall based on attendance numbers given, so volume is not set by SOBGS. Could say lower amount of people.
- Some discussion about reducing speaker costs
- There has to be more communication with Hillary and Beth about the BGRF budget
- SOGS report by J. Slade
 - Upcoming referendum regarding post-residency fees
 - Q: Any progress on lawsuit? A: Exec issued a ruling declaring no one could discuss the matter further
- Union report by J. Matheson
 - o Food bank fund is out of money, but may receive boost from other PSAC monies
- Graduate education committee report by T. Thorne
 - o Will be ranking OGS applications with C. Dieleman
- Seminar committee report by J. Konopka
 - Presentation of recent seminar experience survey: students from AgCan indicate transportation keeps them from attending
 - Currently planning a shuttle to bring students to seminars from AgCan, if there is enough interest and department will contribute to gas money
 - Other small extras like lactose-free options, student baking being considered to improve experience

 - Looking for ways to increase profile of biology department similar to that of physics, chemistry, and other sciences; not strong at self-promotion
 - Asks fellow students to forward ideas by the end of the week (Feb 2) on how to increase visibility and profile of biology department
