





Clinical Academic Faculty Position Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology - Division of Reproductive Endocrinology & Infertility Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry, Western University

The Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, London Health Sciences Centre and Western University, London Ontario, Canada, is seeking a full time clinical academic position in Reproductive Endocrinology & Infertility (REI). The successful candidate will hold a full-time Limited Term Academic appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor or Associate Professor, or a Continuing Clinical Academic appointment at the rank of Associate Professor or Professor, depending upon experience and qualifications at the time of appointment. Candidates must hold an MD and be eligible for licensing in the Province of Ontario. Specialist certification in Obstetrics and Gynaecology through the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or equivalent is required. A formal fellowship in Reproductive Endocrinology & Infertility is required. Training and/or experience in research with an established track record of publications would be an asset. The successful candidate will also have a commitment to and demonstrated aptitude for teaching, and will be expected to teach at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels and to supervise Ob/Gyn resident trainees.

Responsibilities will include:

- Active participation in team-based health care;
- Active involvement in teaching, at undergraduate and post graduate levels; and
- At least 30-35% time commitment to research, education and/or administrative activities in the Department, Hospital and/or the University,
- Provision of health-care services at London Health Sciences Centre and the OMEGA Fertility Center, which is affiliated with Western University.
