A candidacy **examination committee** will consist of three members. Two members will usually be from the student's advisory committee (selected from members in the Kinesiology program, but can include members from other departments/research institutes from within or outside the University). The advisory committee may choose to invite someone from outside the advisory committee to act as an "expert" examiner. The supervisor may choose to serve as the third examiner. In the case of co-supervisors, only one supervisor may serve as an examiner. Supervisors can also choose to remain at "arm's length" throughout the proceedings, in which case a third examiner and an examination "chair" will be invited to participate in the proceedings. At the time of formation of the examination committee, and before the student begins preparation for the exam, it is the responsibility of the supervisor to submit the list of examiners to the Kinesiology Graduate Office for approval.
