

Faculty of Health Sciences Master's Funding Package Top-Up Policy

Research supervisors may provide funding to their Master's students (first or second year) above the funding package which is provided to the student from The Faculty of Health Sciences. This funding comes from the supervisor's research grant(s) and is provided to a student in consideration of their grant-related research activities which are agreed upon by the supervisor and student. Masters students holding scholarship(s) are not eligible for FHS matched funding. Please confirm with your area's Graduate Program Assistant if he/she has received scholarship funding.

Beginning in the 2018-19 academic year, the Faculty of Health Sciences will match this "top-up" funding to a maximum of \$1,500 (i.e., the supervisor contributes \$1500 above the student's funding package, and FHS also contributes \$1500 above the student's funding package).

Please see page 2 of this document for a template letter to be completed and sent to the Dean's Office (kmalone7@uwo.ca) prior to sending to student. The grant top-up, and the matching funds, will be provided directly to the student from the Dean's Office in a lump-sum payment.
