

Research Participant Commitments

1

Respecting the Research Protocol

- Follow instructions given by researchers or nursing staff
- Attend scheduled appointments (visits, examinations, tests, etc.)
- Respect prescriptions (medication, diet, physical activity, etc.)



2

Provide honest and complete information

- Answer questions accurately (medical history, symptoms, behaviors, etc.)
- Inform the researchers of any adverse effects or changes in health during the study



3

Collaborate with the research team

- Actively cooperate with researchers and healthcare personnel.
- Report any difficulties encountered (side effects, personal constraints, misunderstandings, etc.).



4

Respect protocol confidentiality

- Do not divulge confidential information relating to the methodology or products tested, if required by the protocol (especially in double-blind trials)



5

Respect other participants

- Behave respectfully towards other volunteers if interaction is expected.
- Do not interfere with the study or influence the responses of other participants.



6

Inform in case of withdrawal

- Inform the research team if you wish to interrupt your participation (which remains a fundamental right).
- If possible, agree to participate in a post-retirement follow-up for safety reasons.
