INTRODUCTION

Health professionals in Canada have much to learn about innovative health-related solutions. The interdisciplinary School of Health Studies (SHS) has been active in preparing future health professionals to address imminent challenges. Scandinavian countries have progressive health systems and learning about them while developing global competencies is vital in preparing YOU for future careers.

Objective of the Global Skills Opportunity project is to increase the number and diversity of Health Studies students studying and working internationally. International collaborators include higher education institutions and community partners in Norway, Sweden, Denmark, and Iceland.

Four activities for building global skills include:

- 1. Faculty-led international course Aging Globally: Lessons from Scandinavia
- 2. Summer internships
- 3. Summer programs
- 4. Academic exchanges



GLOBAL SKILLS OPPORTUNITY (GSO)

The Global Skills Opportunity program can provide you with international experiences that will broaden your worldview, develop intercultural skills, build a global network, witness firsthand how health organizations work in Scandinavia, bolster your resume, and unlock your potential as a global citizen.

The School of Health Studies has recently secured more than \$450,000 to support students to engage in international learning experiences in Scandinavia, over the next three years.

A significant portion of the funding will be allocated to **indigenous students, students with disabilities, and low-income students.** Funds will also be available to Health Studies students who do not fit within these identified populations.

1. AGING GLOBALLY: LESSONS FROM SCANDINAVIA

Aging Globally is an international course that introduces students to healthcare systems in three Scandinavian countries: Norway, Sweden and Denmark.

- Third year, half course (0.5 credit) offered in winter term
- Blended in-class course and international study tour:
 - January to April 10 weekly mandatory lectures and tutorials
 - May 10-day study trip through Scandinavia
- Enrollment by permission only following application and selection process (September-November)

2. SUMMER INTERNSHIPS

- Summer 2022 approximately 6 weeks
 - Summer 2023 & 2024 length of internships may increase (up to 16 weeks)
- Internships may be paid or unpaid (depending on organization)
- Students may find own opportunity for summer 2022 and qualify for funding
 - Requires approval from Health Studies coordinators
- Course Credit:
 - Summer 2022, intersession course (May to June)
 - 0.5 credit
 - Enrollment by permission with approved internship



3. SUMMER PROGRAMS

With the support of GSO funding, students can enroll in short-term summer courses and programs in Scandinavia, earning credits towards your degree.

Western currently offers two summer programs with institutions in Denmark – Aarhus University and the University of Copenhagen. Over the coming years, will be creating new summer opportunities in Scandinavia for Health Studies students.

We encourage students to also seek their own summer program opportunities.
