4. Business arising from previous meeting.

4.1 Campus Updates

- Health, Safety and Well-Being provided updates on the progress of the WorkSafe @
 Western platform. Development includes inventories for hazardous products,
 inspections, safety program management and safety related assets. Incident reports and
 training records, including Hazardous Communication Form, are still in the plans.
- Health, Safety and Well-Being provided an information update related to the vaccination clinic that was run at Thames Hall 2350 people participated.
- Western continues to be mask friendly. Masks are available near large classrooms and in libraries for members of the community.
- Test kits for COVID can be provided upon request to Health, Safety and Well-Being
- Facilities Management reported that wastewater testing program for campus specific locations has concluded.
- No updates on the policy reviews.

4.2 Follow up – Ministry of Labour Field Visit

Actions related to the field visit of October 11th have been completed. Equipment
guarding was upgraded to conform with guarding standards for the machine that was
involved in the worker injury.

5. Review and Assess Trends

5.1 Accident/Injury Report

- As of the end of October 2023, 257 incidents have been reported on campus: 169 First Aid related incidents, 39 Lost Time related incidents, 41 Health Care related incidents and 11 Near miss/Hazard reports.
- Committee reviewed 37 incidents that occurred in October. 23 First Aid, 9 Lost Time and 5 Health Care.
- Monthly incident rates for October are similar to historical data (3 and 5 year

averages) for this month on campus.

5.2 Critical injuries

 One accident in November resulted in a fractured leg. This was reported to the Ministry of Labour and they investigated on November 15th 2023. The investigation was completed, and no orders were issued.

5.3 Workplace Inspections

- Data from October 12th, 2023 November 14th, 2023
- 9 inspection dates completed in 10 buildings.
- 129 items found for corrective action by units inspected during the inspection cycle.
- Reportable Items.
 - o 72 orders are open for action and 57 orders have been completed.
 - o 2 items are past due from previous inspections.

6.1 WSIB-HSEP

- Health Safety and Well-Being reported that a new round of submissions to the WSIB Health and Safety Excellence Program is being prepared.

- Members of the committee will be engaged in supporting these initiatives related to reviewing materials hazard control, workplace procedures, and inspections of areas where these hazards exist.
- Updates on submissions will be provided at future meetings once milestones related to the program are achieved.

6.2 Ministry of Labour – Field Visit

- Health Safety and Well-Being reported regarding a MOL site visit on November 15th, 2023.
- Two items were investigated during the field visit.
- MOL investigated a reported workplace injury.
- MOL investigated a reported hazard in a building related to an installed ceiling tile.
- The MOL inspector issued orders related to some observed tiles that could possibly fall.
- Committee discussion related to the processes involved for corrective actions for both the immediate items for action and for long term solutions related to installation areas around campus.
