## 4.1 Campus Updates

- Health Safety and Well-Being and Occupational Health Physician provided at situational update on campus.
  - Items of focus are due to past accident reports Sharps injury reporting in professional programs, improved training in animal handling
- Health and Wellness Fair was hosted on May 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- Discussion on processes for Hazard Communications and Reporting of Incidents.
  - o Communication with leaders to complete forms if needed
  - Suggestion to improve training related to reporting requirements
- HSW Director reported online safety training modules are under review
- Designated substances Asbestos new workers being provided guidance and learning by experienced personnel

### 5. Review and Assess Trends

#### 5.1 Accident/Injury Report

- As of the end of April 2023, 139 incidents have been reported on campus: 85
  First Aid related incidents, 23 Lost Time related incidents, 28 Health Care related
  incidents and 3 Hazard reports.
- In March 2023, 32 incidents were reported; 21 of which were First Aid related, 7 Health Care related and 7 Lost Time related.
- In April 2023, 30 incidents were reported; 19 of which were First Aid related, 7 Health Care related and 4 Lost Time related.
- In April 2023, Food Services accounted for 38% of cases, while Facilities
   Management accounted for 35% and Animal Care for 6%, the balance of the
   reports came from 7 other units on campus.
- When compared to historical data from 2021 and 2022, March incidents were

slightly less, and April incidents slightly higher. This could be attributed to an increased return to work on campus.

## 5.3 Workplace Inspections

- Data from March 30<sup>th</sup>- May 9<sup>th</sup> 2023.
- 7 inspection dates completed in 14 buildings.
- 21 items found for corrective action by units inspected.
- WorkSafe@Western platform was used for inspections on May 9<sup>th</sup> 2023.
- Reportable Items.
  - 12 orders outstanding for corrective actions (10 actions are from WorkSafe@Western)
  - No items past due

## 6.1 WSIB-HSEP

   Association (PSHSA), Western's program reviewer, and WSIB for adjudication.
- Thanks for the work done by the JOHSC and business units over the past year in reviewing, rolling out programs and supporting submissions.

### **6.2** Workplace Notice Boards

- Health Safety and Well-Being presented possible change in deployment of workplace notice boards
- Current deployment every building has a notice board.
- Proposed change notice boards to be posted in selected high traffic buildings in conspicuous locations and a virtual notice board is available to assist workers in access to required information.
- Committee supports to change in official notice board locations and provide a virtual version for workers.

## 6.3 Regulatory and Compliance Updates

- Naloxone Kits for "High-Risk" workplaces
  - Workplaces in Ontario who fall in "high risk" must meet requirements by June 1<sup>st</sup> 2023
  - Western has assessed our workplace and believe that we do not meet the criteria for "high risk"
  - o Occupational Health Physician advised that SERT (student emergency

response team) carries Naloxone as a possible life saving measure for a member of the campus community

Increased Penalties under OHSA are in place as a result of the Working for Workers Act

#### Worksafe@Western 6.5

- Inspection module has gone live (May 2023)
- This will be the primary tool for inspections by the JOHSC for workplace inspections and managing compliance.
