

How to find your collaborations using OpenAlex

1. Visit the webpage <https://openalex.org/>, search by either your ORCID or name.

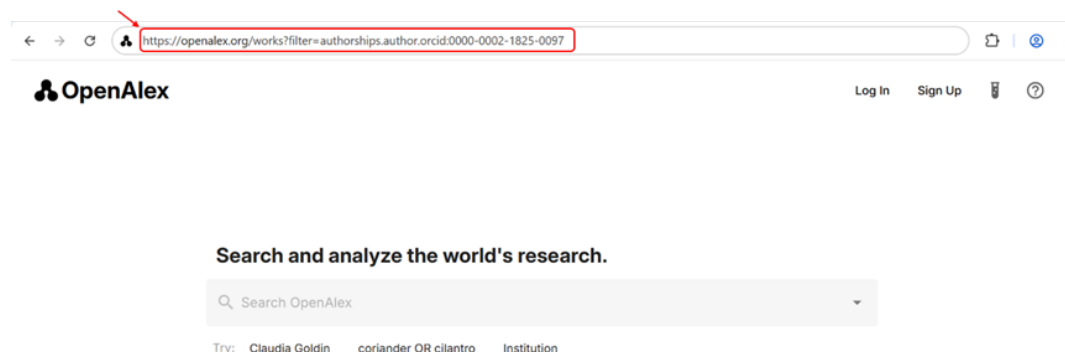
a. To search by ORCID

Type in the following query in the browser URL field:

“<https://openalex.org/works?filter=authorships.author.orcid:>”, followed by your ORCID id, then press “Enter” on your keyboard.

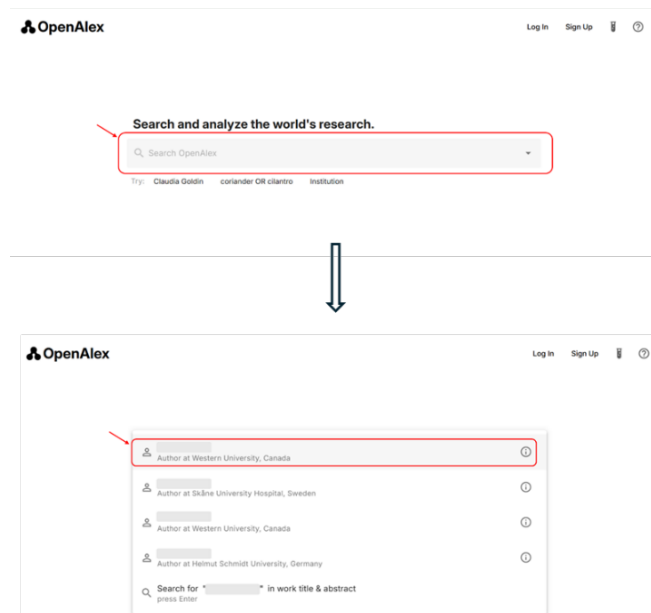
For example:

<https://openalex.org/works?filter=authorships.author.orcid:0000-0002-1825-0097>

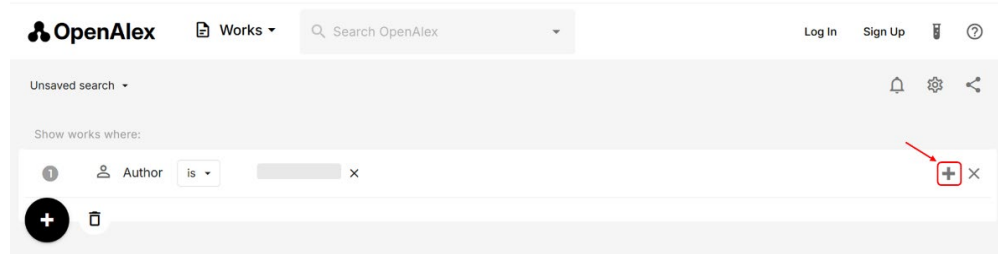


b. To search by name

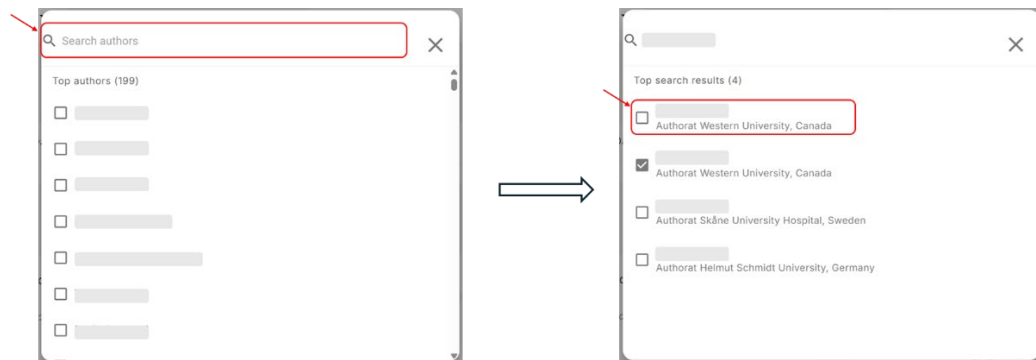
Type in your name (format: “[first name] [last name]”) in the search box. Click on the corresponding author record after verifying the affiliated institution. Then you will be led to a new webpage with works and summary stats listed.



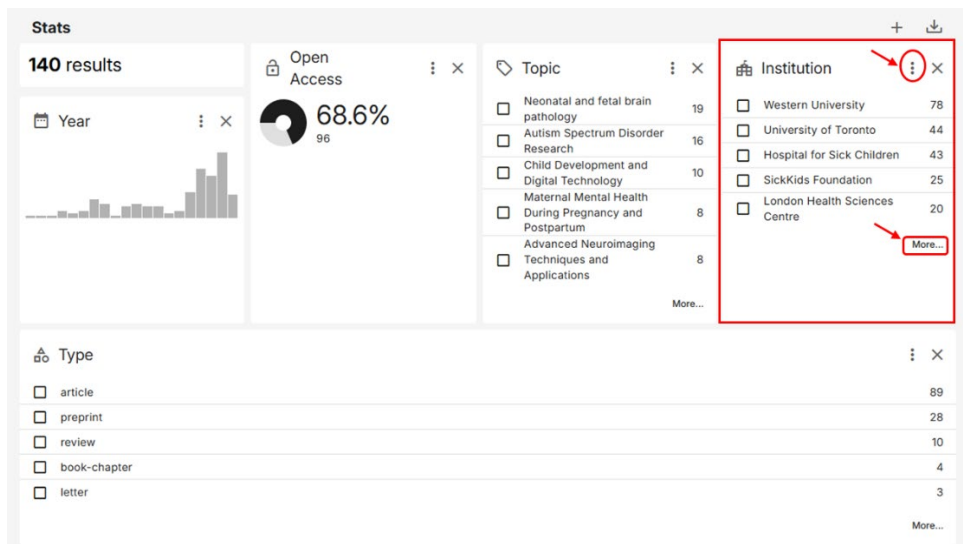
- If you are cross appointed with multiple affiliations or there are multiple author records with the same affiliation of interest (e.g, 2 author records affiliated with Western University), click on the “+” button with the “Author” filter.



Type in your name in the pop-up search box, then select the corresponding author record that you'd like to add to the search results.



- The tile “Institution” in the summary stats includes the top 200 institutions/ organizations with scholars co-authored with you. The full list can be viewed in the browser by clicking on “More...”, and it can be downloaded as a CSV file by clicking on the three vertical dots.



- More summary stats related to collaborations can be added to the report by clicking on the “+” button at the top-right corner of the stats section, including countries/regions of the collaborating institutions/organizations, their institution types, and more.
