

LifeWorks Continuing Career Scholarship in Actuarial Science

(formerly Morneau Shepell Career Scholarship)

Awarded to an undergraduate student in second year Honors Specialization Actuarial Science or Double Major that includes Actuarial Science, who has achieved high academic standing (minimum 75%), has demonstrated leadership abilities, and is committed to participating in two, four-month work experiences with the defined contribution pension consulting team at LifeWorks following second year and third year. Candidates must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents eligible for employment in Canada. The work term generally will be in Toronto, Ontario, however, opportunities may be available in other LifeWorks Offices across Canada, including Montreal or Vancouver, depending on availability. Recipients will be paid at standard rates for the student consulting pool within the LifeWorks organization for the work term, exclusive of the scholarship.

A one-page statement must be submitted by September 30th to the Department of Statistical and Actuarial Sciences describing the candidate's leadership abilities and their interest in a career in Actuarial Science or consulting, and commitment to summer employment with LifeWorks. Selection will be made by the Scholarship committee within the Department of Statistical and Actuarial Sciences. Recipients will be notified of selection by October 31.

The recipient will continue to receive the scholarship in third year, provided they maintain a 75% average on a full course load. Only one student will hold this scholarship during any year. This scholarship was established with a generous donation from LifeWorks.

Value: 1 at \$3,000, continuing for two years for a total of \$6,000 per recipient.

Application Deadline – September 30

It is possible to receive both a LifeWorks Scholarship and a University of Western Ontario Continuing Scholarship

- 1. I have included a one-page statement as described above.
- 2. I give permission to the Scholarship Committee to print and view my academic record.
- 3. I understand that if I withdraw from the honors Actuarial Science program, I forfeit the award permanently
- 4. I understand that my continuing scholarship is based upon maintenance of an 75% or greater average on a full course load.
- 5. I will participate in summer employment with LifeWorks after both second and third year.
