Awarded annually to a student graduating in 4th year from Honours Actuarial Sciences, who has demonstrated a strong understanding of ethics in Actuarial Sciences through their course achievements and statement submission. Candidates will be asked to complete an application form by **February 28** and to provide a statement on the importance of ethics in the actuarial profession, as well as their personal ethics philosophy.

The scholarship and awards committee in the Department of Statistical and Actuarial Sciences will select the recipient based on consideration of both their course achievements and the statement submission.
