I'm seeking election to Western University Senate because I care about the long-term academic strength of the University—and I want to contribute to decisions that shape the student experience, academic quality, and Western's reputation.

I've been on faculty at Western for 17 years, and I currently serve as an Associate Professor at the Ivey Business School in the Business, Economics and Public Policy group. My research and teaching focus on how organizations respond to public policy, especially in regulated industries—work that has been supported by SSHRC grants and recognized through a Fulbright Scholar appointment. I've also been deeply involved in academic leadership and governance at Western. I previously served as the Program Director for Ivey's MBA Programs, chaired Ivey's Curriculum and Program Review Committee, and have sat on

Senate before as an SGPS Representative. Those roles gave me a practical view of how university decisions land in classrooms, programs, and student outcomes. If elected, I'll bring Senate a faculty perspective shaped by program leadership, curriculum renewal, and a strong focus on keeping Western student-centered and academically ambitious.
