Admission Requirements:

Completion of first-year requirements, including 1.0 courses either from Art History 1640 or the former VAH 1040, or two of AH 1641A/B, AH 1642A/B, AH 1644A/B, AH 1646A/B or AH 1648A/B, or the former VAH 1041A/B, the former VAH 1042A/B, the former VAH 1043A/B, the former VAH 1045A/B, with a minimum grade of 60% in each course.
